- Created one-stop COVID-19 webpage to keep members informed with the latest national, state and local developments.
- Held first-ever Virtual Fall Convention, including statewide awards and 2021 officer installations.
- Launched Tennessee Virtual Speaker Series (TNVSS) to bring insights to members remotely.

ADVOCACY

- Worked with Gov. Bill Lee's administration and the General Assembly to ensure real estate remained an essential service.

- Maintained strong, vital relationships with state legislators throughout the pandemic.
- Championed involvement in the REALTORS® Political Action Committee and saw investments in RPAC top \$800k as of late October.




