Authorizes the senate or house of representatives government operations committees to request an agency to re-promulgate a rule that has been in effect for eight or more years or repeal a rule that has been deemed obsolete. States that if an agency does not comply with a request within 90 days that it is subject to having its rulemaking authority suspended. Broadly captioned.
